

May 13, 2020 Meeting Minutes

- Washington D.C. Conference Nov. 6-9
 - We will go down a day early to ensure we are able to register on time.
 - Transportation options discussed: CSA van or two personal vehicles (to fit all members and luggage)
 - \$1700 conference cost + parking (\$40/day @hotel) + registration fee
 - The cost for the conference breaks down to \$537/person
 - If classes have not resumed in-person in the fall, we will not attend the D.C. conference in November.
- Regardless of whether classes resume in-person, the club will look at conducting some online fundraisers.
- President Taylor discussed applying for travel grant for our members attending the Fall conference in D.C. which would be a minimum of \$200/person up to a maximum of \$500/person.
- Discussed staying at the conference hotel (or very nearby) or using an AirBnB and using the metro to get to the conference. The consensus seemed to be that staying at the conference hotel was the best for the club.
- Spring is likely to be in-person and the club will look at attending NY conference if unable to attend the conference in the Fall.
- The country our delegation was assigned is Ireland. GA1 (Nick), GA2 (Joe), UNEA (Bridget), ECOSOC (Taylor), UN Habitat (Austin, Brendon) are the committee assignments.
- The club will look at weekly meetings beginning in September regardless of in-person classes. Only as-needed meeting until then.
- October all fees for attending the D.C. conference are due.
 - In the event that we are unable to attend the conference, the club will look to refund costs incurred by members where possible.
- Position Papers for the D.C. conference are due on Oct. 16, 2020.
