

Clarion University Student Senate Meeting Minutes
February 22, 2021

- I. Call to Order
 - A. President Mason called the meeting of the Spring 2021 semester of the Clarion University Student Senate to order at 7:30.
- II. Roll Call
 - A. Absent: Senator Barboza
- III. Additions to the Agenda

- IV. Approval of the Minutes

- VI. Officers' Reports
 - A. Vice President of Student Affairs - Dr. Fenske
 - 1. The Clarion family experienced a tragic loss this past weekend. If you feel like you need to talk to someone, or you know someone who is struggling, please utilize the counseling services offered through the university.
 - 2. There will be a survey sent out about integration.
 - 3. The fees will not be sent out to the Trustees until around July this year because of all the fluctuations due to COVID-19.
 - B. Advisor's Report - Mr. Shaffer
 - 1. If you are concerned about yourself or others, please utilize the counseling services that are offered.
 - C. Director's/Board of Director's Report - Ms. Machokas
 - 1. Please check out CU Connect, and encourage others to look at it. There are a lot of programs being offered for students.
 - D. President's Report - President Mason
 - 1. Dr. Gent, the provost, visited Student Senate to go over academic concerns, but also came to students with some questions.
 - a) Most students agreed that taking more than one or two online courses a semester would turn them off of continuing a program or going to the university.
 - b) Senator Custer asked if the university is going to become more lenient with the courses that are offered and substituted when Clarion integrates with CalU and Edinboro.

- (1) There will be a new curriculum that will be used, and students will not be in school for longer than they need to be to be able to graduate.
- c) Trustee Krupa asked about having faculty be given opportunities to learn about teaching in different environments when going through integration.
 - (1) Someone came in over winter break to teach faculty about teaching multimodal and online already. They meet regularly in small groups. Additionally, there are opportunities for professors to learn how to better their teaching skills. Unfortunately, these cannot be forced on to professors, but it is available.
- d) Secretary Robinson asked if there was a way to make it mandatory for professors to record zoom lectures, particularly due to a medical emergency or health condition, especially when the professor is not being compliant.
 - (1) Unfortunately, there is no way to make the recordings to be mandatory, but students should reach out to Ron Radakar and Disabilities Services to make accommodations.
- e) If students are having trouble with a professor actually teaching material and they do not use D2L, send your concerns to department chairs or Dr. Gent.
- f) There are rumors that the Psychology Department is basically going to cease to exist from Clarion.
 - (1) The Psychology Department will be one department among all three integrated schools. There will be professors at each campus though. However, there is the possibility of some retirements happening soon so Clarion is working on some contingency plans.
- g) Senator Barrett brought up the concern of taking an online class from one of the integrated schools while being at Clarion. Which school's policies are you supposed to follow?
 - (1) Essentially, there is a group working to figure out the best way to combine these sorts of policies like grading and recording during test-taking.
- h) VP Boyle wanted to know if advising is being kept in mind during the integration process.
 - (1) There is a working group that is focusing on advising and how to ensure student success.

- i) Since the curriculum will be changing soon with the integration, Dr. Gent said she will look into getting student input on programs and curricula.
