# Edinboro ‘Staff Member of the Year’ nominations due March 28

**EDINBORO** – Every academic year, Edinboro University recognizes one carefully selected staff member, awarding them for outstanding service to the university and EU students. Faculty, staff and students are all eligible to submit nominations for the ‘Staff Member of the Year’ category. According to the President’s Office, selections are due by Monday, March 28.

Anyone wishing to nominate faculty must fill out the online form and provide specific examples of award criteria, including that nominee’s outstanding qualities. The form can be found on the university’s [Staff Member of the Year webpage](#). The online nomination form can also be printed and mailed to Ghering Health and Wellness Center. Applications submitted late will not be accepted. Any staff member who has previously been awarded Staff Member of the Year is not eligible.

In order to qualify for the award, the person “must be current, non-faculty, employees of Edinboro University who are in good standing, have passed the initial probationary period and have served Edinboro University for at least a total of 12 months,” as stated on the university website.

The criteria also states that nominees should serve the campus community in significant ways, in alignment with the following characteristics and qualities: positive attitude, leadership, expertise, efficiency, commitment to quality, personalized/innovative approach, impact, and/or constituent experience.
